SMALLTALK

- Fun (stuff)




QUESTIONS AND QUESTIONS

- Why ask questions?
- generic, boring or interesting?
- surface, or deep? (Big talk?)
- Yes/No reply, or a full sentence? (avoid open-ended Qs)



EVERYDAY ENGLISH INCLUDES...

- · Idioms, slang and cultural references!
- Academic, Business English are starting points. Lead to Functional language only. Not practical, everyday.
- Watch TV/YouTube/Stream, ask friends, be open and have a sense of humour.
